

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS: AMERICAN JOURNAL OF BARIATRIC MEDICINE

The *American Journal of Bariatric Medicine* actively encourages the submission of scientific articles specifically concerning practicing bariatricians and dealing with clinical issues in the treatment of obesity and related conditions. Articles about the business aspects of administering a bariatric practice are strongly encouraged.

Editorial Review

All manuscripts are submitted to the Editorial Review Board. Notification of acceptance, rejection or conditional acceptance (subject to required changes) is usually provided within two months after acknowledgment of manuscript receipt. Publication follows as soon as possible depending on the current backlog of articles. Authors of accepted manuscripts receive an honorarium of \$300 payable following publication.

Manuscripts

- Word process all text, references and tabular material in caps and lowercase, double-spaced with one-inch margins all around. Leave right margins unjustified (ragged). Number all pages consecutively.
- Check that all references, tables and figures are cited in the text in numerical order.
- For human or animal experimental investigations, state that the project was approved by an appropriate institutional review board, or when no formal ethics review process is in place, state the manner in which informed consent was obtained from human subjects.
- Describe basic study design, define all statistical methods used, and list measurement instruments, methods and tools used for independent and dependent variables.
- In the Materials and Methods section, identify all interventions used in a manner inconsistent with approved or standard usage.
- Provide a cover letter including the author(s) full name(s), academic title and/or position, address, telephone number, email and, if applicable, institution from which the work initiated. ASBP members should indicate their first year of Society membership.

Illustrations

Submit illustrations and graphics in electronic format, indicating the first author's name, the figure number and the top of the figure.

Permissions

Obtain written permission from the publisher and author to use previously published illustrations and submit these letters with the manuscripts. Obtain written permission from patients to use their photos if there is a possibility they will be recognized. In the case of a minor, permission must be obtained that summarizes the main points of the paper and its conclusions.

References

- References are required for all material derived from the work of others. Cite all references in numerical order in superscript in the text. The list of references at the end of the manuscript should list references in numerical order. If there are references used as general source material but from which no information was taken, list them in alphabetical order following the numbered references.
- For journals, include the name(s) of the author(s), complete article title, journal name (in Index Medicus abbreviated form), volume number, date and inclusive page numbers. For books, include the name(s) of the author(s) and/or editor(s), name and location of publisher and year of publication. List page numbers for exact quotations.
- Authors should review past issues of the journal for its reference format. Authors may be asked to reformat references to conform to the style.

Editorial Processing

All accepted articles are subject to copy editing.

- For Original Contributions and Brief Reports, authors must provide photocopies of all references so that statements cited in the text can be identified.
- Authors may be asked to modify their manuscript to include suggestions made by members of the Editorial Review Committee, including copy editing.
- When the manuscript is in final, corrected form, authors will be asked to submit one hard copy of the corrected manuscript via email or on a disk.
- When the manuscript is submitted in final form, authors will be asked to submit a Transfer of Copyright, transferring copyright of the article to the ASBP. Authors will retain all rights to use the article as they wish, provided that appropriate copyright recognition is given to the ASBP.
